

# The Story Behind the Saengerfest Concert Chorus

Since then, this all-volunteer, non-profit chorus has grown from the 45 original members to a dynamic 70 voice men's ensemble, having performed 56 concerts in its first ten years, most of them benefits for Greater Boston charities.

In this our tenth anniversary season, we look forward to continuing our mission of performing to help others and singing to help ourselves.





# The Story Behind the *Saengerfest* Concert Chorus 1992 – 2001

The original Saengerfest was founded about 1901 by a group of close friends at the Harvard Medical School who enjoyed singing together in private and wished to continue after graduating. Today's membership of over 150 men has diversified and grown far beyond the original number of young doctors, but members continue the tradition of addressing each other as "Doctor", whatever their professions may be. The parent organization meets quarterly.

The Saengerfest Concert Chorus was formed in the fall of 1992 following the return from England of a group of 45 members of the parent Saengerfest, who joined 18 Welsh male choirs in a 950 voice concert in Royal Albert Hall. It was their first public appearance as a group!

Since then, this all-volunteer, non-profit 70 voice men's chorus has performed in concert halls, churches and cathedrals all over New England, in Canada and in England, in varied programs of choral music including classical music, liturgical and sacred music, folk songs, love songs, college songs, Victorian and early-modern parlor pieces and spirituals. Many of the chorus's appearances are benefit concerts for charities.

And in its fourth appearance in London's Royal Albert Hall, the Chorus took part in the October 2000, 1000 voice *Millennium International Concert of Male Choirs* featuring choruses from Australia, Canada, England, Scotland, South Africa, Wales and the United States. The Chorus also gave a solo concert at Winchester Cathedral as it did in 1998 at Salisbury Cathedral.

The Beginnings of the Welsh Connection Back in the 1960's, Samuel S. Rogers was given a record of Welsh male choirs by his wife, Andy. It was so enthralling that Sam began to collect as many recordings of Welsh male choirs as he could find. Some of the best were tapes and cds of the bi-annual Festival of Welsh Male Choirs given in London's Royal Albert Hall.

Sam and Andy had traveled frequently in England and Wales occasionally attending rehearsals of local male choirs. In the spring of 1990, they were visiting Andy's cousin in Wiltshire and attended a concert of Verdi's Requiem in the Albert Hall with the London Philharmonic Orchestra and a mixed choir of 250 voices.

Later as they drove through South Wales, they stopped at the Brecon Beacon National Park Information Center to ask directions concerning a back road through the mountains. "Maybe since they're a Welsh information center", Andy said, "they would know how we could get tickets to a Welsh choir concert in London." She asked the desk clerk who didn't know but she would ask her husband that evening. Could we telephone early the next morning?

**First exposure to Welsh choirs** The next morning Sam called and was put in touch with Ray Taylor, secretary of the London Welsh Male Choir, the organizer of the Albert Hall Welsh Festivals. After hearing that Sam was also a singer, Ray sprang for four tickets to the Albert Hall concert that coming October. Not only that, he invited the Rogers and their cousins to the Thursday night rehearsal before the Saturday concert, and to meet the officers and conductor of the London Welsh Choir!

So, that fall in 1991, the Rogers flew back to London and the Thursday evening rehearsal prior to the Saturday evening Albert Hall concert. The Montreal choir was the overseas visitor that year and they met the Montreal people as well as a lot of the London group and conductor Haydn James. Graciously, they were invited to the Imperial College after the concert to enjoy the afterconcert party.

In the midst of the party, Ray Taylor said to Sam, "If your choir (the parent *Saengerfest*) were to be invited, would they be interested in being the overseas choir in the 1992 Albert Hall concert?" After a stunned silence, Sam explained that the *Saengerfest* never sang in public but there might be a group who would be interested. He'd get back to them.

At the next rehearsal of the parent *Saengerfest* in Cambridge, Massachusetts, Sam related the tale and asked if there was any interest. 50 hands shot up! So they got organized; found a rehearsal site at Fenn School in Concord, Massachusetts; a conductor, David Huston; and an accompanist, Janie Briscoe. Beginning that January, the original group of 38 singers rehearsed every Monday evening. With the help of tapes and phonetic translations of the Welsh lyrics, they memorized the entire concert!

1992... First Public Appearance... Royal Albert Hall! That July, Haydn James flew from London to Boston for two nights of rehearsals. His opinion was that the group knew their music cold but could benefit from a little concert experience. In any case, they would be welcome in London in October!

In October 1992, the "Boston Saengerfest Chorus" together with their wives and a number of groupies, flew off to London and a fabulous adventure! Meeting the members of the 17 Welsh choirs, they rehearsed only once altogether on the day of the concert. And that Saturday night, with the adrenaline rushing, the Saengerfesters sang in their first public appearance in 90 years!

At the party following the concert, happily exhausted and noisily joining in the informal groups of songsters, Sam was approached by Haydn James, music director of the London Welsh Choir, and Ray Taylor — and was asked if the Boston group would be interesting in returning in two years (1994) for the Jubilee International Festival of Welsh Male Choirs. The answer was an instantaneous YES! At that moment, the Saengerfest Concert Chorus was born!

#### The Saengerfest Concert Chorus Today (2001)

The *Saengerfest* Concert Chorus is a men's choir of 70 voices, mostly men in their 40's, 50's 60's and 70's, founded in 1991 among members of a century-old men's musical/social group that continues to meet quarterly. We are a not-for-profit [501(c)(3)] organization whose explicit mission is to perform for charities for a nominal fee as part of their fund-raising efforts.

Currently, we sing a repertoire patterned after the traditional Welsh Men's Chorus repertoire: classical music, including opera excerpts; liturgical and sacred music; folk songs; Victorian and early-modern parlor pieces; love songs and college songs; Broadway music. We avoid barbershop style arrangements and most pop music. We sing some a cappella arrangements and generally use piano accompaniment; we perform several numbers with organ accompaniment when available.

Our audiences vary, but because we sing for fund-raising events—and because we are mostly in our 50's-70's—our audiences are generally middle-aged and older, educated, modestly affluent, and aware of what used to be a prevalent school and college art form, the men's glee club. We have performed four times in London's Royal Albert Hall, and in England's Salisbury and Winchester Cathedrals.

Our members come from the greater Boston area, and several commute from southern New Hampshire and Rhode Island. We perform all of our concerts from memory; the majority of members sight read quite well; new music is quickly learned; many sang in their college glee clubs and choirs; some currently sing in their church choirs; and several are professionally trained.

We discourage time-wasting at rehearsals but we appreciate the benefits of camaraderie, and therefore several times during the year we plan social occasions, usually receptions following concerts. We rehearse Monday evenings at the First Parish (Unitarian) in Weston. We sing for the joy of singing and working hard—our rehearsals are as rewarding as our concerts! We perform to help others; we sing to help ourselves.










